

Brevard County Pet Sterilization Program

APPLICATION

Brevard County offers low-cost pet sterilization to eligible Brevard County residents. Surgery is provided by local veterinarians and clinics **for a co-pay of \$20 per animal**. Proof of current rabies immunization is required or a rabies shot will be provided at no additional charge. A distemper shot is also offered at no additional charge. Other services requested, provided, or deemed necessary by the veterinarian may be incurred at the pet guardian's expense.
